Nursing Program Cohorts

Students interested in the Nursing program can enroll in either a day or evening cohort.

The day cohort classes; lecture, lab and clinical, are scheduled between 6AM-9PM.

The evening cohort classes; lecture, lab and clinical, are scheduled between 2PM-10PM. This spring is the first time we are running the evening program thanks to SUNY transformational money.

Non-NUR courses required (General Psychology, English Composition, etc.) are offered in a variety of blocks/modalities to accommodate students' schedules



What is New for 2025?

Grants

Transformational (SUNY):

This grant has enabled the Nursing program to offer wrap around services to students working on applying to the program. A full-time Student Navigator serves as an Advisor/Mentor assisting with more intrusive academic and social services support for all cohorts.

High Needs Simulation grant (SUNY):

This grant will enable the Nursing program to continue to offer high quality nursing simulation experiences to nursing students in the lab.

Mother Cabrini Healthcare Foundation (private):

This grant will enable the Nursing department to continue to add new faculty to offer more seats to students. This allows the program to continue to grow.



What is New for 2025?

- NYSED Approved: application to begin a Certified Nursing Assistant training program which will begin in Spring 2025. Enrollment - 16 students.
- NYSED Approved: an accelerated LPN-RN cohort has been approved by SUNY and the NYS Department of Education. This cohort will begin in May 2025. Enrollment - 16 students.
- 2025 Bootcamp: NCLEX review program for former SUNY Sullivan graduates who have not passed the NCLEX. May-August 2025.
