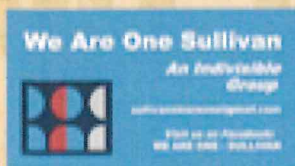

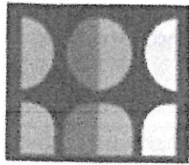

Dear Members of the Legislature:

WeAreOne Sullivan, WAOS, organized originally in response to the first Trump presidency, is part of a nationwide movement that has brought millions of everyday Americans onto the streets in coordinated protests and rallies to say, No Kings Here! WAOS is now responding to Trump's second term and will sponsor No Kings 3 on Saturday, March 28th, from 1 to 3 pm, in Monticello. The sidewalk rally will originate in front of the Sullivan County Courthouse at 414 Broadway and will continue along the sidewalks on both sides of Broadway. Our co-sponsors are N.A.A.C.P. Chapter 2187B, Sullivan Allies Leading Together (S.A.L.T.), the Committee for Equity and Justice, Transgender Support Initiative, and Catskills Pride. We hope you will be able to attend.

Below is a summary of some of our actions in 2025.

- April 5: WAOS held our first protest of the Trump 2 administration, "**Hands Off**", in the pouring, freezing rain as D.O.G.E. decimated our system of government. An estimated 300 concerned citizens came and stayed in spite of the weather.
- May 1: Several hundred of us gathered on the sidewalks of Liberty in a quickly organized after-work protest.
- June 14: We held our first "**No Kings**" march on Broadway, in Monticello. Approximately 1,000 people were in attendance.
- July 7: WAOS held a memorial celebration of the late Congressman, John R. Lewis, entitled "**Good Trouble Lives On**". Our program included pastors, community organizers, gospel, and other singers. We had four co-sponsors demonstrating our unity and diversity. It was an evening of coalition building in the great humanitarian's name. Over 200 people attended.
- October 18: We held "**No Kings 2**" on both sides of Broadway in Monticello with about 1,200 in attendance.

Peaceful protests have been held every Saturday since July '25, from 1:00 to 2:00 p.m. in front of the Courthouse, 414 Broadway, Monticello. Numbers ranged from 10 to 70 participants; support from drivers-by was overwhelmingly positive.

We envision a country where all people can live with equal rights, dignity, safety, and full participation in democracy. As we approach the 250th anniversary of American Independence and the president is being cast as a king, we will unite on March 28th to let him and his supporters know that in America we have No Kings!!

We, the people, are concerned about the state of our constitutional rights, the militarization of our cities, as well as the price of groceries, electricity, healthcare and housing. Rural healthcare is on life support. We have had enough of the assault by the Trump administration on our constitution, our form of government, our families, and our neighbors. When due process becomes meaningless to those in control, we must rise, and a shared sense of humanity must prevail. We invite you to join us on March 28th and every day.
