SULLIVAN COUNTY LEGISLATIVE PROCLAMATION

Proclamation Designating June as LGBTQIA2S+ Pride Month

Whereas, the Legislature of the County of Sullivan recognizes the right of every citizen to experience equality and freedom from discrimination; and

Whereas, all people regardless of age, race, creed, color, national origin, sexual orientation, gender identity or expression, military status, sex, marital status, or disability have the right to be treated on the basis of their intrinsic value as human beings; and

Whereas, the County of Sullivan welcomes people of diverse backgrounds and believes a diverse population leads to a more vibrant and accepting community; and

Whereas, the County of Sullivan commits to advocating for a fair and equitable society, free from institutional injustice, prejudice, bigotry, and bias, and to foster a society that allows individuals to freely display their personal expression and identity; and

Whereas, the County of Sullivan commits to support and uplift the LGBTQIA2S+ (Lesbian, Gay, Bisexual, Transgender and/or Gender Expansive, Queer and/or Questioning, Intersex, Asexual, Two-Spirit and others who self identify) community every day of the year; and

Whereas, the County of Sullivan condemns the rise in acts of violence against the LGBTQIA2S+ community and the increasing attacks on the rights and freedoms of the LGBTQIA2S+ community across our country; and

Whereas, each year the month of June represents LGBTQIA2S+ Pride Month to honor the June 28, 1969 Stonewall Uprising and the work of Marsha P. Johnson, Sylvia Rivera, Stormé DeLarverie and other LGBTQIA2S+ activists and to celebrate the accomplishments and contributions of the LGBTQIA2S+ community; and

Whereas, to acknowledge the efforts to bring awareness to the LGBTQIA2S+ community the County of Sullivan will display the Progress Pride Flag at the Sullivan County Government Center for the month of June; and

Now, Therefore, Be it Resolved that the Legislature of the County of Sullivan does hereby proclaim June 2025 LGBTQIA2S+ Pride Month in Sullivan County and affirms its commitment of support to the LGBTQIA2S+ community.
