

WHEREAS, the County of Sullivan Personnel Office is required by Civil Service Law to administer Civil Service Exams;

WHEREAS, there are several upcoming exams, to wit: (1) Administrative Assistant; (2) Police Officer/Deputy Sheriff; (3) Director of Food Services; (4) Family Services Investigator Trainee; (5) Family Services Investigator; (6) Senior Family Services Investigator; and (7) School Lunch Manager, with a large number of applicants scheduled for May 3, 2025;

WHEREAS, the aforesaid exams would typically be held at Sullivan County Community College, which venue already has a conflicting scheduled event on May 3, 2025;

WHEREAS, Resorts World has offered to waive their usual space fee, generously donating the space needed to host the May 3, 2025 exams, and

RESOLUTION INTRODUCED BY HUMAN RESOURCES COMMITTEE TO ESTABLISH A POLICY PROHIBITING THE USE OF RECORDING DEVICES

WHEREAS, it is the objective of the County to create a work place environment that reflects and supports the respectful treatment of all employees; and

WHEREAS, the County wishes to adopt the following policy regarding the prohibited use of recording devices in the work place; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Sullivan County Legislature adopt and implement the policy prohibiting the use of recording devices as annexed.

PROHIBITED USE OF RECORDING DEVICES:

Unauthorized electronic surveillance of employees is disruptive to employee morale and inconsistent with the respectful treatment of our employees. For this reason, no employee may record the conversation of another employee without his/her/their full knowledge and written consent.

No employee may record, by any means, a conversation with another employee, or customer, unless all of the following criteria are met:

- 1. There is a legitimate business purpose for the recording;
- 2. The recording device is in plain view of all participants; and
- 3. Written authorization is obtained from the individual(s) being recorded.

Secret recordings are strictly prohibited unless authorized in writing. A violation of this policy may result in disciplinary action up to, and including, termination/Section 75 charges.

WHEREAS, Resolution Number 234-24 authorized the County Manager to execute a contract with Brown and Brown to analyze, review, and recommend equivalent health care replacement for the phasing out of the Excelsior Plan by NYSHIP; and

WHEREAS, the County of Sullivan proceeded with securing the alternative health insurance plan as provided by Brown and Brown, which now requires an annual contract, and

WHEREAS, the contract period for these services shall be for one (1) year, to wit, January 1, 2025 to December 31, 2025, and may be renewed annually for up to four (4) years; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Sullivan County Legislature authorizes the County Manager to sign any and all of the necessary agreements, contracts and documentation, in such form as the County Attorney shall approve, to contract for said broker services not to exceed \$93,000 annually to be paid by Anthem; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that a certified copy of this resolution be attached to any necessary agreements in connection with this project; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that this resolution shall take effect immediately.


WHEREAS, the Charter designates powers and duties of the County Auditor and allows for a Deputy County Auditor position within the Office of Audit and Control as authorized by the Legislature within appropriations provided; and

WHEREAS, in the 2025 budget there is a vacant Staff Auditor position that can be abolished to create a Deputy County Auditor position; and

WHEREAS, the funds budgeted for the Staff Auditor position will partially fund the Deputy Auditor position and additional funds are needed for the position of Deputy County Auditor position;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Sullivan County Legislature hereby abolishes the Staff Auditor position and hereby creates a Deputy County Auditor position in the Office of Audit and Control; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOVED, the Sullivan County Legislature authorizes the funding of this position.

WHEREAS, the Office of Audit and Control ("Department") is responsible for the auditing all claims and charges against the County or against funds that the County is responsible for; and

WHEREAS, there is a need to create an Accounts Payable Coordinator position within the Department to assist with the timely process claims;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that an Accounts Payable Coordinator position be created in the Office of Audit and Control; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that upon the future vacancy of position number 892, it is hereby abolished.
