WHEREAS, the New York State Division of Criminal Justice Services (DCJS) is prepared to provide \$28,510.00 in funding for the ATI program for the programmatic term of July 1, 2025, through June 30, 2026, and

WHEREAS, in order to access the funding, the County must enter into an agreement with DCJS.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Sullivan County Legislature hereby authorizes the County Manager, Chairman of the County Legislature, and/ or their authorized representative to enter into the agreement with DCJS to acquire the funding and to execute all other documents necessary to comply with funding source requirements, said document(s) to be in a form approved by the County Attorney's Office.

RESOLUTION INTRODUCED BY THE PLANNING & COMMUNITY RESOURCES COMMITTEE TO AUTHORIZE AN AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE SULLIVAN COUNTY VETERANS SERVICE AGENCY AND SULLIVAN COUNTY TRANSPORTATION

WHEREAS, the County of Sullivan ("County"), by the Sullivan County Veterans Service Agency ("Veterans"), provides medical transportation services to eligible Sullivan County veterans; and

WHEREAS, the Veterans need to acquire the services of a transportation service provider in order to transport eligible veterans to local medical appointments within Sullivan County and to the Veterans Affairs medical centers in Castle Point and Albany; and

WHEREAS, Sullivan County Transportation Department ("SCTD"), a department under the Sullivan County Division of Community Resources ("Community Resources"), has the expertise and resources required to provide the necessary transportation services; and

WHEREAS, in order for SCTD to provide the transportation services requested by Veterans, it will be necessary for the County, SCTD, and Veterans to enter into a three-party Memorandum of Agreement ("Agreement"). The Agreement will be for three (3) years (2025, 2026 & 2027) with an annual payment for each calendar year not to exceed \$150,000.00.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the Sullivan County Manager, is hereby authorized to execute the Agreement for calendar years 2025, 2026 and 2027 at an annual cost not to exceed \$150,000.00 as described above. The contract shall be in a form approved by the County Attorney.

MEMORANDUM OF AGREEMENT BETWEEN SULLIVAN COUNTY VETERANS SERVICE AGENCY AND

SULLIVAN COUNTY DIVISION OF COMMUNITY RESOURCES

During the calendar years of 2025, 2026 and 2027, the Sullivan County Division of Community Resources (SCDCR) does hereby agree to provide transportation services for the Sullivan County Veterans Service Agency (SCVSA) to accomplish the transportation service goals described below:

Sullivan County Transportation (SCT), a department under the SCDCR, will be the direct provider of the service. SCT will provide one (1) driver and one (1) van to transport veterans to the Albany Stratton VA (Veterans) Hospital, Albany, New York, Monday through Friday, with the exception of holidays or inclement weather. The van will arrive at the Albany Stratton VA at 9:00 am and will depart at 2:00 pm. A larger van/bus will be provided to transport veterans to the Albany Stratton VA Hospital, Albany, New York whenever more than fourteen (14) veterans must be transported on a given day.

SCT will provide one (1) driver and one (1) van to transport Veterans to the VA (Veterans) Hudson Valley Healthcare Hospital, Castle Point Campus, Castle Point, New York, Monday through Friday, with the exception of holidays or inclement weather. The van will arrive at the Castle Point VA Campus at 9:00 am and will depart at 2:00 pm. A larger van/bus will be provided to transport veterans to the VA Hudson Valley Healthcare Hospital, Castle Point Campus, Castle Point, New York whenever more than fourteen (14) Veterans must be transported on a given day.

The trip sheets shall be delivered to SCT by 12 pm, with unavoidable exceptions allowed when SCT is notified by 12 pm, the day prior to the trip.

SCT will provide one (1) driver and one (1) van to transport Veterans to local medical appointments, within Sullivan County, Monday through Friday, with the exception of holidays or inclement weather. Appointment times must be made between 8:00 am and 2:00 pm. A larger van/bus will be provided to transport veterans to local medical appointments whenever more than fourteen (14) Veterans must be transported on a given day.

The trip sheets for local appointments shall be delivered to SCT as soon as the appointments are taken, with a minimum of three (3) days' notice. Unavoidable exceptions may be allowed at the discretion of SCT, when notified immediately.

A wheelchair accessible van will be provided to transport veterans with a one (1) or two (2) days' notice.

Home pickup will be provided for trips to both VA hospitals and local medical appointments with a medical note from a doctor.

The Sullivan County Veterans Service Agency will reimburse the Sullivan County Transportation department as follows:

A standard County of Sullivan voucher will be sent to the Sullivan County Transportation department, by the Sullivan County Veterans Service Agency, quarterly for claim of payment. Total payments for this service will total \$150,000, annually, for the calendar years of 2025, 2026 and 2027.

RESOLUTION INTRODUCED BY PUBLIC SAFETY AND LAW ENFORCEMENT COMMITTEE OPPOSING NEW YORK STATE GOVERNOR HOCHUL'S EXECUTIVE ORDER NUMBER 47.3 CONCERNING COUNTY HIRING OF FORMER EMPLOYEES OF NEW YORK STATE DEPARTMENT OF CORRECTIONS AND COMMUNITY SUPERVISION

WHEREAS, on March 10, 2025 Governor Hochul issued Executive Order No. 47.3 that temporarily suspends or modifies Civil Service Law, County Law, Municipal Home Rule Law, Correction Law and Criminal Procedure Law to "Prohibit the appointment, transfer and promotion of any individual previously employed by the Department of Corrections and Community Supervision employees", and

WHEREAS, the Sullivan County Jail and Corrections Officers have for decades provided for the care and custody of persons awaiting trial, convicts, and others, but has in recent years experienced significant staff shortages which strain the facility's remaining workforce, who nonetheless diligently and commendably endeavor to maintain the safe and secure operation of the Correctional Facility and thereby protect and serve the public, and

WHEREAS, in a time when local governments, including Sullivan County, are grappling with severe staffing shortages and the need for qualified, experienced personnel, Governor Hochul's executive order only exacerbates the crisis, and

WHEREAS, it is unthinkable and outrageous that in the same breath, that she push for second changes through the Clean State Act, she is denying those who have devoted their careers to public service the chance to continue their work and support their families.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Sullivan County Legislature hereby strongly opposes Governor Hochul's Executive Order No. 47.3 and urge her to reconsider this ill-conceived order and

immediately reverse her decision.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that a certified copy of this resolution be sent to Governor Kathy Hochul, Assemblywoman Paula Kay, Senator Peter Oberacker, Assemblyman Brian Maher and the New York State Association of Counties.
