

Board of Elections Report
Government Services
October 10, 2024

The Board of Elections has been extremely busy over the past couple months preparing for the upcoming Presidential Election, as well as registering voters and processing and issuing Absentee/Early Vote by Mail ballots. To date we have issued approximately 5,400 ballots for this year's General Election.

The BOE conducted Inspector Training last week, which was attended by more than two hundred Inspectors over three days.

Our office was open on Saturday, October 5th from 2pm until 9pm to receive Voter Registrations.

Important Dates, Deadlines & Information:

- ❖ October 26th is the last day for the Board of Elections to receive a Voter Registration by mail or in person (our office will be open from 9am until 5pm). This is also the last day for the BOE to receive an Absentee /Early Vote by Mail application by mail.
 - Any Voter may request a postage paid Early Vote by Mail Ballot (no reason required), by paper application or via the online portal:

- ❖ October 21st is the last day for the BOE to receive a change of address from a Voter.
- ❖ The BOE will have extended hours on the following dates:
 - Tuesday, October 22nd 9am until 7pm
 - Thursday, October 24th 9am until 7pm
 - Tuesday, October 29th 9am until 8pm
 - Thursday, October 31st 9am until 8pm
- ❖ Early Voting runs from Saturday, October 26th until Sunday, November 3rd at the Sullivan County Government Center in Monticello and Public Health in Liberty. The hours are posted on our website at:

As always, there is no Early Voting the day before the election (Monday, November 4th).
- ❖ Election Day is Tuesday, November 5th. All Poll Sites will be open from 6am until 9pm in Sullivan County.
