

SULLIVAN COUNTY LEGISLATURE PROCLAMATION

WHEREAS, April 9, 2025, will be observed as "Education & Sharing Day" in the United States, continuing a national tradition established in 1978 to recognize the monumental contributions of the Rebbe, Rabbi Menachem M. Schneerson, of righteous memory, for the advancement of education and ethical values for all Americans; and
