The 'why' behind Encouraging Healthy Behaviors Amongst Our Local Heroes

- > 70% of our firefighters struggle with obesity
- > 50% of our firefighters are either diabetic or pre-diabetic
- > 50% of our firefighters have high blood pressure
- > 90% of our firefighters have poor diet and exercise habits
- Firefighters hold the highest rate of suicide of all first responders




