I don't think anyone was surprised that Mr. Doherty's team of loyal supporters voted for him to remain Chair of this legislature last week, because they have almost always lined up squarely to stand in his shadow no matter what, for the last almost four years. He did not mention anybody else on the board. It must be nice to be the bestie of Mr. Doherty so that you are free to do whatever you please regardless of those silly bylaws. I read the agreement between Archtop Fiber and Sullivan County that Mr. Brooks and Mr. Potosek hailed as a great triumph, and it doesn't really commit Archtop to anything. It's signed by Michelle and an Archtop exec.. Sullivan County is nowhere on the Archtop Fiber website, which contains a map of the territories they plan to expand to, and Sullivan County is mentioned nowhere in the Archtop Fiber News. The agreement didn't go through any board approval, since there were no LDC meetings, and there was no legislative approval either in any resolution or committee. Let's not even talk about Open Meeting Laws. Everything that LDC has supposedly done this year is illegal.
