## Financials

As stated last month, our caseload numbers are constantly climbing. We received 22 new supervision cases in the month of April and the court orders for Pre-Sentence Investigations have more than doubled from the month prior.

## Community Events/ Relations/ Training

We hosted the annual PTR/ATI board meeting on April 14, 2026. During this meeting the program contract was discussed. So far in the 2025-2026 contract, which began 7/1/25, we have had 38 defendants sentenced to community service. We have also had 35 successful completions since 7/1/25.

## Pre-Trial Release

-For the 2023-2024 contract, we ended up with 96 total releases.

-For the 2024-2025 contract, we had 111 total releases.

**-For the 2025-2026 contract which began 7/1/25, we have already had 150 total releases.**

There are currently 147 defendants under supervision of the PTR program. This does not include pending cases of individuals who are currently incarcerated or in inpatient treatment programs.

For the fiscal year contract 2025-2026, we received \$251,627.00. We have allocated this funding for training costs, Body Worn Cameras, overtime/night visits/curfew checks, Corrisoft phone program, drug testing kits/lab expenses, and additional equipment for the Probation Department.

We placed two large orders for items to place in the Care Bags. We bought socks, gloves, hats, toiletries, blankets and many other items. With these orders, we also added chicken salad, tuna salad and ham salad lunch packs, along with applesauce, and other snacks. We often find those that need these bags are often hungry and these bags seem to be very well received and needed.
