The New York State Department of Transportation (NYSDOT) would like to update you on a culvert replacement project in your community. Project Identification Number (PIN) 9TCR19/D264352 will replace five culverts located in Chenango, Delaware and Sullivan Counties. One of the culverts planned to be replaced is Culvert Identification Number (CIN) C970031, which carries State Route 42 over Hemlock Lake Drain, near the intersection of Hemlock Lane, in the town of Thompson, Sullivan County. A project location map is enclosed for your reference.

This work is scheduled to begin during the 2022 construction season. Two-way traffic will be maintained on site during construction by shifting the travel lanes. Within the work zone, each travel lane will be temporarily narrowed to 10 ft. and adjacent shoulders will be narrowed to 2 ft. Work is scheduled to be completed by the end of the construction season; however, the project schedule is subject to change based on the weather, project details, and as overall capital program resources dictate.



The New York State Department of Transportation (NYSDOT) would like to notify you of four upcoming short term (weekend) closures of Interstate Bridge #6 at Cohecton, which carries Cohecton Dam Road (Sullivan County Route 114)/ Cohecton Turnpike (PA 371) over the Delaware River connecting the Towns of Cohecton in Sullivan County and Damascus in Wayne County, PA.

Currently the bridge is open to alternating one-way traffic controlled by a temporary traffic signal while it is being rehabilitated. Unforeseen circumstances related to construction activities require four short term Saturday to Sunday closures of the bridge.

Weather permitting, the first two closures are expected to begin Saturday, April 9, and Saturday, April 16, at about 6:00 am each day. The bridge will reopen to alternating one-way traffic around mid-day the following day, Sunday, April 10 and April 17 respectively.

A second set of similar time frame weekend closures is expected to occur later in the Spring or Summer. Electronic message signs will alert drivers in advance of the closures, and emergency response vehicles will still be allowed to cross the bridge while the closures are in place. If weather or other factors delay any of the planned closures, the work will be moved to the next suitable weekend and will follow the same general schedule.

Construction for this project is expected to be completed by the end of this year.

The New York State Department of Transportation (NYSDOT) would like to notify you of an upcoming bridge maintenance project in your community. Project Identification Number (PIN) 906780, contract number D264711, will address bridge piers, abutments and stream bank erosion on the bridges that carry Route 17 over DeBruce Road (County Road 81) and Willowemoc Creek in the town of Rockland, Sullivan County. A project location map is enclosed for your reference.

This project is scheduled to be completed during the 2022 construction season. Traffic will be shifted on Route 17 westbound at Interchange 96, with the shoulder and deceleration lane closed during the construction. The interchange and ramps will remain open. Shoulders on DuBruce Road (County Road 81) will be closed within the work site. Both lanes of vehicle traffic on DeBruce Road will remain open, although temporary traffic impacts directed via flaggers should be expected within the work zone. The work will also necessitate the closure of the NYS DEC parking area provided for fishing access. Currently, it is anticipated that construction work zone restrictions including the fishing access parking area closure will begin May 1st and continue through September 30th, although this schedule is subject to change based on weather, project details, and as overall capital program resources dictate.



Dear Senators, Assemblymembers and Mr. Mujica:

As you may be aware, Governor Hochul has appropriately taken steps to release an Inspector General's report outlining various concerns for the Catskill Off Track Betting Corporation (OTB). Catskill OTB has shown a precipitous decline in revenue sharing with counties, leaving taxpayers to make up the difference.


We are aware of legislation advanced by Senators Skoufis and Martucci which would replace the Board of Directors of Catskill OTB and support same. We respectfully ask that language be included in the State budget, or otherwise adopted forthwith:

1. Terminating the existing Catskill OTB Directors;
2. Directing that the Officers/employees of Catskill OTB only be permitted to pay such bills as may be authorized by the State Gaming Commission or its Executive Director pending the appointment of a new Catskill OTB Board;
3. We ask that Counties be required to appoint a new Board member within forty-five days, report the names and addresses of the new directors to the Executive Director of the State Gaming Commission; and
4. Authorize the Executive Director of the State Gaming Commission to designate a temporary Chair to convene a meeting of the new board of Catskill OTB and that the staff of the Gaming Commission be temporarily authorized to provide such assistance as may be necessary to the new Board.


