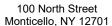

RESOLUTION INTRODUCED BY PUBLIC SAFETY AND LAW ENFORCEMENT COMMITTEE TO AMEND RESOLUTION NO. 108-21

WHEREAS, pursuant to Resolution No. 342-19, adopted by the County Legislature on September 19, 2019, National Medical Services Labs (NMS) 3701 Welsh Road, Willow Grove, PA 19090, was awarded a contract for medical-legal death investigation testing services required by the Coroner's Office being the vendor that Catskill Regional Medical Center

Coroner's Office being the vendor that Catskill Regional Medical Center contracts with, providing continuity to the process, and

WHEREAS, in order to continue providing adequate toxicology services to the Coroner's Office, there is a need to increase the not-to-exceed dollar amount authorized in Resolution No. 108-21 from \$41,000 to \$45,000 to cover expenses through 1/1/2022-12/31/2022

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that Resolution No. 108-21 is hereby amended to authorize a total not-to-exceed amount of \$45,000.00 for the period of January 1st, 2022 through December 31st, 2022,

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the County Manager is hereby authorized to enter into a Modification Agreement with National Medical Services Labs to increase the total not-to-exceed amount for the period January 1st, 2022 through December 31st, 2022 from \$41,000 to \$45,000 and said agreement to be in such form as the County Attorney shall approve.

Provision of Postmortem Toxicology Testing

This Agreement is made effective on <u>January 1st, 2022</u>, between the County of Sullivan ("County"), a municipal corporation with offices at the Sullivan County Government Center, 100 North Street, Monticello, New York 12701, and National Medical Services Inc., (d.b.a. NMS Labs) with offices at 200 Welsh Road, Horsham, PA 19044 ("Contractor").

- This Modification Agreement shall modify the Agreement between the parties dated January 1, 2018, ("Original Agreement"), and entered into pursuant to Resolution No. 29-18, adopted by the Sullivan County Legislature on January 18, 2018, Resolution No. 342-19, adopted by the Sullivan County Legislature on September 19, 2019, and Resolution No. 108-21, adopted by the Sullivan County Legislature on March 18, 2021.
