#### Division of Community Resources Monthly Report Workforce Development April 2024

#### Workforce Development

- ✓ On March 23<sup>rd</sup> Congress passed the final six Fiscal Year (FY) 2024 appropriations bills that included Labor, Health and human Services and Education. The bill funds three-quarters of the government until October 2024. The FY24 spending levels for the Workforce Innovation and Opportunities Act (WIOA) connected programs are mainly equal to current PY23 funding levels.
- ✓ The Center for Workforce Development (CWD) has a NYS Systems Change and Inclusive Opportunities Network (NYSCION) grant through NYS Department of Labor (NYSDOL). This grant provides funding for a Disability Resource Coordinator (DRC) who works to support and expand partnerships, collaborations, service coordination and delivery across workforce, education and disability service systems. The DRC works with businesses and with individuals who are in receipt of SSI or SSDI and want to work.

The CWD is hosting is "Empowering Towards Independence" workforce summit was held March 12, 2024 at the Kartrite. There were 100 people in attendance representing businesses, providers and consumers. Surveys received after the event were very positive and people felt that they increased their knowledge.

- ✓ The contract with HC Staffing and Training to provide Certified Nurse Assistant and Home Health Aide training has been signed. A facility use agreement between the County and SC BOCES is under development. Working to iron out some issues with company who does the universal background checks for the healthcare industry.
- ✓ An agreement has been signed with SC BOCES for Automotive training. The class is scheduled to begin April 9<sup>th</sup> at the SC BOCES campus in Liberty. The class will meet Tuesdays and Thursdays from 5:30pm – 9:00pm. There are 15 slots and currently 36 applicants.

- ✓ The CWD sent an email blast to County departments and vendors offering a presentation/review of services of the CWD and other departments under the Division of Community Resources. This is being conducted for outreach purposes to bring awareness of what services are available with new and changing staff. To date 14 presentations have been completed and several more are scheduled. This outreach efforts have led to relationship building and increased collaborative opportunities.
- ✓ NYSDOL applied for \$10 million in Round 3 of the Federal National Dislocated Worker Emergency grant to address the Opioid crisis. The CWD signed on to participate if NYS is awarded. This will provide funding for training and employment for individuals directly or indirectly impacted by the Opioid crisis.
- ✓ The in-house hiring events are underway for 2024. There were three (3) events in March that brought seven (7) businesses to the Career Center.
  - April 4<sup>th</sup> from 11:00am 2:00 pm will have ARC of the Greater Hudson Valley and Monticello Motor Club
  - April 11<sup>th</sup> from 11:00am 2:00pm will have Anytime Home Care and Eitan Houri, DVM.
- ✓ Career Center data updates: Social media:
  - 951 followers; February 2024 had a reach of 13,150 people with 605 Facebook page views.
  - Center Services:
    - The CWD provided services to 16 business customers and listed 123 jobs in the month of February.
    - The CWD assisted 569 participants that came into the Career Center for the month of February 2024.
    - Welfare to Work caseload profile February 2024: Total Caseload - 296

# Labor Market Data for February 2024 compared to February 2023

✓ Sullivan County saw an increase in total nonfarm jobs of 4.2% (1,200) and an increase of 5.2% (1,200) in total private sector jobs.

*Please note*: The net month (January 2024 – February 2024) showed an increase of 0.3% (100) nonfarm jobs and no job gains in private sector jobs.

- ✓ NYS showed an increase of 1.3% (124,100) in total nonfarm jobs and 1.1% (91,200) in private sector jobs.

- Leisure & Hospitality at 4.5% (38,300)
- Government at 2.3% (32,900)
- Financial Activities at 0.8% (6,200)
- Other Services at 1.0% (3,700)

NYS saw job losses in:

- ✓ Within the region, Sullivan County's private employment sector grew the fastest year-over-year, up 5.2 percent. The second fastest growth was recorded in the Kingston MSA (+2.7%) followed by the Dutchess-Putnam Metropolitan Division (+2.5%), followed by and Orange-Rockland-Westchester labor market area (+0.5%).
- ✓ The Hudson Valley region showed an increase of 1.1% (10,500) in total nonfarm jobs and an increase of 1.0% (8,200) in private sector jobs.

- ✓ Sullivan County's unemployment rate was 4.5% for February 2024 up from 3.8% in February 2023.

February 2024 had 38,100 people in the labor force (36,400 employed & 1,700 unemployed). The number of employed individuals increased 1.7% (600) and the number of unemployed increased by 21.4% (300) leaving the labor force with a net gain of 2.4% (900).

The total labor force decreased -0.3% (-100) from January 2024 to February 2024. There number of employed workers decreased by -0.5% (-200) and the number of unemployed workers increased by 6.3% (100).

- ✓ The Hudson Valley's unemployment rate for February 2024 was 4.0%, an increase from 3.4% in February 2023.
- ✓ NYS's unemployment rate was 4.5% in February 2024 compared to 3.4% in February 2023.

#### ACTIVITY REPORT -MARCH 2024 COUNTY OF SULLIVAN INDUSTRIAL DEVELOPMENT AGENCY (IDA), SULLIVAN COUNTY FUNDING CORPORATION (SCFC), THE SULLIVAN COUNTY INFRASTRUCTURE LOCAL DEVELOPMENT CORPORATION (TSCILDC)

March 29, 2024

The IDA Board held its regular monthly meeting on February 12<sup>th</sup> to conduct routine business.

The SCFC Board also met on February 12<sup>th</sup>, at which time they conducted the annual review and approval of SCFC's procurement policy, investment policy, disposition of real property guidelines, mission statement, and performance measurements. The SCFC Board also adopted a resolution authorizing the issuance of replacement bonds relating to the Sullivan County Community College Dormitory Corporation project. The bonds have been purchased by Amos Financial LLC, and the replacement bonds will reflect Amos as bond holder.

During February and March IDA staff made four Payment in Lieu of Tax (PILOT) distributions to the taxing jurisdictions, totaling approximately \$4,620,000.

Staff has finished drafting the 2023 IDA, SCFC, and TSCILDC annual reports to the New York State Authorities Budget Office, to be filed through the Public Authorities Reporting Information System (PARIS) by the end of March. The internal audits of the IDA, SCFC, and TSCILDC have also been completed.

On Wednesday, March 27<sup>th</sup>, IDA held a public hearing relating to the proposed Monticello Kosher Supermarket LLC project in the Village of Monticello. It is anticipated that the IDA Board will discuss and vote on project approval at its upcoming meeting on April 8<sup>th</sup>.

The March IDA Board meeting has been rescheduled from Monday, March 11<sup>th</sup> to Friday, March 29<sup>th</sup> at 1:00 PM in the Legislative Hearing Room at the Sullivan County Government Center. SCFC and TSILDC will also meet that afternoon. All three agencies are expected to review and accept their annual audited financial statements and PARIS reports at that time.

The new Kansas City Barbeque Society sanctioned event in June has grown into a full 4 meat barbeque and attracting teams from across the Northeast. #### FAST FACTS

According to the recently released data, 2022 traveler spending in Sullivan County reached a record high of \$892 million a 25.8 % increase over 2021's \$710 million in traveler spending. Since 2019 visitor expenditures increased 154.4 %. Were it not for tourism-generated state and local taxes, the average household in the county would have to pay an additional \$3,370 to maintain the same level of government revenue, already hard hit by the pandemic.

This boost has brought about a myriad of economic benefits, including increased employment opportunities and support for local businesses. In 2022, total tourism-generated employment registered 4,701 jobs, 16.3% of all jobs, according to Tourism Economics.

### Report to Legislature – April 2024


#### A. <u>Summary</u>

March is typically slow in the development environment as companies begin to ramp up for the upcoming construction season. The mild winter has helped most get a jump on projects though some market fears remain due to inflationary fears and const of financing currently. We made some significant progress on the former Grossinger site in Liberty expeditiously as a local law returning RH zoning has been crafted and presented with some language revisions, opening the door to significant interest in redeveloping the location for its tradition uses.

We continue to work with the Town of Liberty relative to assisting in securing a FAST NY grant for the Old 17 corridor. We have facilitated a professional team to present additional data to help make the case for infrastructure funds needed to make sites there much more competitive. A \$1 million commitment has been announced through the offices of Congressman Molinaro for a specific location which certainly helps Liberty's chances.

Once again Sullivan County has been deemed by NYSDOL, with the fastest job growth in the region, though unemployment ticked up despite adding 1,700 jobs year to year.

Unemployment rates throughout the State did go up year to year with Sullivan above 4%. However, with new job hires expected to b significant going into 2025 we should continue our growth trajectory.

#### B. Project Updates

#### 1. Corporate Attraction

- A Resort Hotel and Golf Course developer has expressed serious interest in the Grossinger site. We are working closely to help facilitate the project and move it forward.
- We are working with an out of state broker interested in the Horizons Liberty 1 million sq. ft preapproved site. The broker remains engaged as we work to help the Town of Liberty secure funding for infrastructure improvements. A second prospect has emerged. We are competing with another location, though we are told we are in the lead due to our pre-approved status. Again, infrastructure is a major factor.
- We are facilitating a 91-room hotel project in the Town of Thompson. Ongoing.
- Apple Ice (RGG Realty, LLC) is seeking to expand its current building to produce and distribute ice products in its territories. A developers agreement has been executed in order to ensure water capacity for the project. Ongoing.

#### 2. Small Business/Entrepreneurial Development

- We are working with SC Planning facilitating an a Restore NY application for a developer that plans to rehabilitate several facilities on Broadway in Monticello.
- We are assisting a local landscape property maintenance firm with the construction of a new facility on Old Route 17. The firms core business is lawn care, grading and snow plowing.
- Reviewing a revolving loan application for a childcare center. Ongoing
- Working with a NYC restauranter interested in rehabbing existing property, in the Town of Rockland, highlighting the craft beverage and hospitality industries. Ongoing.

#### 3. Business Expansion

• Three businesses will consolidate at a new location in the Town of Thompson. This will involve the construction of two new facilities in order to accommodate the current and expanding operations of each. Ongong.

#### 4. Shovel Ready Sites

 We continue to facilitate the development of preapproved sites in Liberty, Thompson, and Fallsburg. Two new locations representing 2 million sq. ft of space will be seeking approvals this year bring the total upon completion of nearly 5 million sq. ft of space preapproved for development in total. 5. **Membership Education/Special Events** – we will be hosting our annual Economic Development Summitt at the Kartrite Hotel on April 10, 2024. The event is sold out.
