RESOLUTION INTRODUCED BY THE PUBLIC WORKS COMMITTEE TO AUTHORIZE THE COUNTY MANAGER TO EXECUTE AN AGREEMENT FOR PAINTING SERVICES FOR REPAINTING OF RUNWAY 15-33 EDGE STRIPES WITH HI-LITE AIRFIELD SERVICES, LLC

WHEREAS, the Division of Public Works (DPW) is required to repaint the runway edge stripes on Runway 15 -33 to come into compliance with Federal Aviation Administration regulation CFR Part 139.311 (d); and

WHEREAS, HI-LITE Painting Services, LLC has competitively bid and won a Sourcewell airfield markings contract #110122-HLA; and

WHEREAS, HI-LITE Painting Services, LLC will supply and apply Waterborne Type III white paint and Type III glass beads over an area 6298 feet in length by 3 feet wide for Runway 15 and Runway 33.
