RESOLUTION INTRODUCED BY NADIA RAJSZ, CHAIR OF THE LEGISLATURE OF THE COUNTY OF SULLIVAN TO CORRECT THE 2024 TAX ROLL OF THE TOWN OF FORESTBURGH FOR TAX MAP #24.-1-4.1
